Charlotte Jane BUCKWORTH was only five months old when she died (18 March 1887) and was buried the following day in **Saint Peter's Cemetery, Onehunga**.

Her parents were **Charles Marshall BUCKWORTH** (1859-1947) and **Emily Maria FULLOON** (1864-1933).

Charles and **Emily** were married at Saint Paul's Anglican Church, Auckland:

BUCKWORTH-FULLOON - On February 22, at St. Paul's Church, by the Rev. C. M. Nelson, Charles Marshall, youngest son of the late Rev. T. E. Buckworth, of Evenlode, Worcestershire, to Emily Maria, only daughter of the late James Fulloon, Esq., Whakatane, and stepdaughter of George Brown, Esq., Government Native Interpreter, Auckland.

Emily Maria BUCKWORTH died 17 May 1933, aged 70:

Buckworth: On May 17, at the residence of her daughter, Mrs. Ernest Harper, 47 Tainui Road. Devonport, **Emily Maria**, after a sudden illness; aged 70 years. Private interment from above address at O'Neill's Point Cemetery, 2.30 pm to-day (Thursday).

Charles Marshall BUCKWORTH died on 1 December 1947, aged 88.
